## Recommended Healthcare for Cats

At Walker County Veterinary Center, we care about your pets and want to help keep them healthy and protected from dangerous and contagious diseases. A three-year rabies vaccination is recognized by the state of Texas and is required by law. Since our area has seen the occurrence of rabies, which is deadly, vaccination is required yearly for clients in Huntsville and is recommended for all. As many of us know, rabies can be passed from infected animals to humans. Other pet vaccinations that are considered “core” by the veterinary community also are highly recommended because they pose the largest risk to your pet.

### KITTENS:

#### 8 Weeks:

- Wellness Exam
- 1st FVRCP
  - Feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, panleukopenia
- 1st Feline Leukemia
- Fecal
- Deworm
- Heartworm/Flea Prevention

#### 12 Weeks:

- 2nd FVRCP
  - Feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, panleukopenia
- 2nd Feline Leukemia
- Heartworm/Flea Prevention

#### 16 Weeks:

- Rabies
- 3rd FVRCP
  - Feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, panleukopenia
- 3rd Feline Leukemia
- Heartworm/Flea Prevention

*Cats can be spayed/  
neutered when they  
reach 4-6 months age.*

### ADULT CATS:

*Any first time vaccinations (excluding Rabies) on an adult cat require a booster one month from the initial vaccination to insure maximum protection.*

#### Annual:

- Wellness Exam
- Rabies
- FVRCP
  - Feline viral rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, panleukopenia
- Feline Leukemia
- Fecal
- Heartworm/Flea Prevention

*\* It is recommended that your cat be tested for Feline Immunodeficiency Virus and Feline Leukemia at 12 weeks or older.*

*\* The dose and cost of deworming and heartworm prevention vary depending upon the cat's weight and the type of product received.*
